



How to replace the drill tail of the furnace front rock

How do you slide a blower assembly back into a furnace?

To slide the blower assembly back into the furnace, you will need to locate the tracks inside the furnace cabinet. The lips on the upper edges of the blower assembly will slide into the tracks when you lift and push the assembly into the furnace. Replace the screws at the top front of the assembly.

How do you remove a blower from a furnace?

There should be 2 to 4 screws in the top of the control panel holding it to the furnace cabinet. Remove the screws and move the control panel to the side. Once the control panel is out of the way, remove the screws holding the blower assembly. These screws are located at the top front of the assembly on most furnaces.

How do you replace a furnace blower assembly?

Slide the blower assembly along the tracks that hold it in place and out of the furnace. If you're replacing the entire assembly, then you're almost done. Connect and slide the new assembly into place. Fasten it, and reposition the control/circuit board.

How do I Reset my furnace in winter?

Replace the furnace panels, turn on power to the furnace, open the gas line and restart the furnace. If all went well, and it should with the above instructions, your furnace will be back in business cranking out heat in winter and assisting air conditioning in hot months.

How is a blast furnace removed?

The removal of all the constituents of the bottom and the hearth of the furnace is carried out usually by salamander tapping. The salamander tapping is usually done at preferably the lowest level where liquid iron can be expected in the blast furnace hearth.

How do you remove a solidified salamander from a furnace?

For the removal of the solidified salamander often requires oxygen lancing and even explosives. These types of removal also cause health and safety hazards. The tapping of the liquid salamander is generally carried out immediately after the blow-down of the furnace.
